

- E.C.E.'s will take into consideration each child's whole life situation when dealing with their behaviour, consulting regularly with parents to develop collaborative strategies to meet children's needs both in the centre and in the home. It is important to share any information that may identify possible stresses that might affect a child's behaviour.
